



Personal Licence Application

Photograph Specification

PHOTOGRAPHS

Applicants for a personal licence must provide two photographs which comply with the following requirements:–

I.

- (a) taken against a light background so that the applicant's features are distinguishable and contrast against the background;
- (b) 45 millimetres by 35 millimetres (passport size);
- (c) full face uncovered and without sunglasses and, unless the applicant wears a head covering due to his religious beliefs, without a head covering;
- (d) on photographic paper; and
- (e) endorsed, with a statement verifying the likeness of the photograph to the applicant by:–
 - (i) the Chief Executive of the licensing justices for the relevant licensing authority,
 - (ii) a solicitor or notary,
 - (iii) a person of standing in the community; or
 - (iv) an individual with a professional qualification.
