



Congratulations to the The Craig Tyler Trust for becoming a registered charity!

We asked Founder and Chair, Karen Pullen, what this means for the trust: "We started the application back in January of this year but because of COVID-19 lockdown in march this made it very difficult to complete so our application expired. We started it again as we came out of lockdown and finally got our registration number. We have been running since June 2018 but due to the regulations needed to be met to become a charity it has taken us 2 years of hard work to get to this point so we are so happy to finally have our registration number and be recognised as a charity, I even cried when I got the email, happy tears of course. For the last 2 years we have worked tirelessly fundraising and training so we have the tools to support our service users. Our drop in centre has been running since march 2019 and although our saturday centre had to close in march because of the premises we ran from wasn't aloud to open under government guidelines, we worked an out reach service throughout lockdown and in September 2020 found premises that we could open Covid compliant and run 2 sessions a week from there, Along with our out reach services. We give out care packages to reduce anxiety and have funding for service users to receive 12 free sessions of professional counselling. We also have a scheme for people in the Basildon borough who has lost their job, been made redundant or been furloughed and who are experiencing financial difficulties to receive help. The Craig Tyler Trust is a charity set up in the memory of a beloved boy who, after a battle with mental ill health, took his own life at the age of 22 in April 2018. Leaving a family grieving immensely but all pulling together to make sure he's never forgotten and all vowing to help as many people as we can!"
