
Public Spaces Protection Order Borough-wide

Basildon Borough, in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014, will be implementing for a duration of 3 years a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO), identifying a Restricted Area, (outlined in the map below), where the activities listed under PROHIBITIONS are prohibited and where a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer or Authorised Council Officers have the power to require persons undertaking any of the restricted actions to cease forthwith.

Restricted Area:

Barn Hall, Barstable Open Space, Cranfield Park, Eversley, Gloucester Park, Kingswood Open Space, Lake Meadows, Markhams Chase, Mopsies Park, Nevendon Park, Northlands Park, Swan Mead Park, Vange Hill Drive Open Space, Victoria Park and Wickford Memorial Park





PROHIBITIONS:

Within the area described, the following are prohibited: -

1. Use of a motor vehicle, without reasonable excuse or the express permission of the Council.

REQUIREMENTS:

A person who is believed to have engaged in a breach of this Order is required to give their name and address to a police officer, police community support officer or other person designated by the Council.

THE EXCEPTION:

Nothing in this order shall apply to a person who is consuming alcohol on premises listed in section 62 of the 2014 Act, the full text of section 62 is set out at Schedule 3 of this Order.
