Digital Inclusion Strategy

Vision or Policy Statement

Basildon Council's ambition is to improve digital connectivity, accessibility, and skills across the borough to ensure that residents can contribute and benefit from existing and emerging digital technologies. As they will have the confidence to navigate services online and the awareness and understanding to be motivated to engage with technology. To improve their wellbeing and realise the associated benefits to their lives through being educated and empowered to participate.
