General Insurance Exclusions</p> <p>Loss or damage caused by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Radiation. • War Risks or Government or Public Authority Order. • Sonic Bangs • Pollution. • Terrorism. <p>Other Interests</p> <p>The Policy contains a blanket admission of interest clause, applicable where the Policyholder so intends. This will apply in respect of interests such as that of shared owner, freeholder, building society or mortgagee, with the nature of such interest to be disclosed in the event of loss.</p> <p>Claim notification</p> <p>If you want to make a claim, please contact the Policyholder at their address. Claims are to be notified as soon as possible, with full details to be provided within 30 days of the claim (7 days in respect of riot or malicious damage) including supporting evidence in writing. The Police must be notified as soon as possible in the event of theft or malicious damage.</p> <p>Cancellation Rights</p> <p>This policy does not entitle you to a cooling-off period.</p> <p>Insurance Act 2015</p> <p>This policy is compliant with the principles of the Insurance Act 2015 law reforms. It also incorporates an 'opt out' which aims to promote good customer outcomes. We have opted-out of the 'proportionate reduction of claim remedy' available to insurers under the Act. This means that in cases of non-disclosure or misrepresentation which are neither deliberate nor reckless, if we would have charged an additional premium had we known the relevant facts, we will charge that premium and pay any claims in full rather than reducing claims payments in proportion to the amount of premium that would have been charged.</p> <p>We believe that our 'additional premium approach' should, in most situations, be more favourable to our customers when compared to the proportionate reduction of claim remedy. Our additional premium approach does not affect our right to apply the other remedies available under the Act for non-disclosure or misrepresentation.</p>	<p>Our Complaints Procedure</p> <p>We are committed to providing a high level of customer service. If you have any cause for complaint please get in touch with your usual contact at Zurich as they will generally be able to provide you with an immediate response to your satisfaction. (Contact details will be provided on correspondence that we or our representatives have sent you.)</p> <p>If you are not happy with the outcome of your complaint, or we have not provided you with a final decision within 8 weeks of receiving your complaint, you can ask the Financial Ombudsman Service to review your case. You will need to contact them within 6 months of the date of our decision letter.</p> <p>The ombudsman can help with most complaints if you are a consumer, a business employing fewer than 10 person that has an annual turnover or balance sheet that does not exceed €2 million, a charity with an annual turnover of less than £1million, a trustee of a trust with a net asset value of less than £1million.
