

# Neighbourhood Area & Neighbourhood Forum Decision Notice

Sections 61F and 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as inserted by Schedule 9 Part 1 of the Localism Act 2011) provides a local planning authority with the power to designate an area as a neighbourhood area and an organisation or body as a neighbourhood forum.

## Publicising a Designation of a Neighbourhood Area

Under the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 Part 2 Regulation 7, the local planning authority must publish on its website, and in other such manner as they consider is likely to bring the designation to the attention of people who, live, work and carry on business in the neighbourhood area:

- The name of the neighbourhood area;
- A map which identifies the area; and
- The name of the relevant body who applied for the designation.

## Publicising a Designation of a Neighbourhood Forum

Under the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended) Part 3 Regulation 10, the local planning authority must publish on its website, and in other such manner as they consider is likely to bring the designation to the attention of people who, live, work and carry on business in the neighbourhood area:

- The name of the neighbourhood forum;
- A copy of the written constitution of the proposed neighbourhood forum;
- The name of the neighbourhood area to which the designation relates; and
- Contact details for at least one member of the neighbourhood forum.

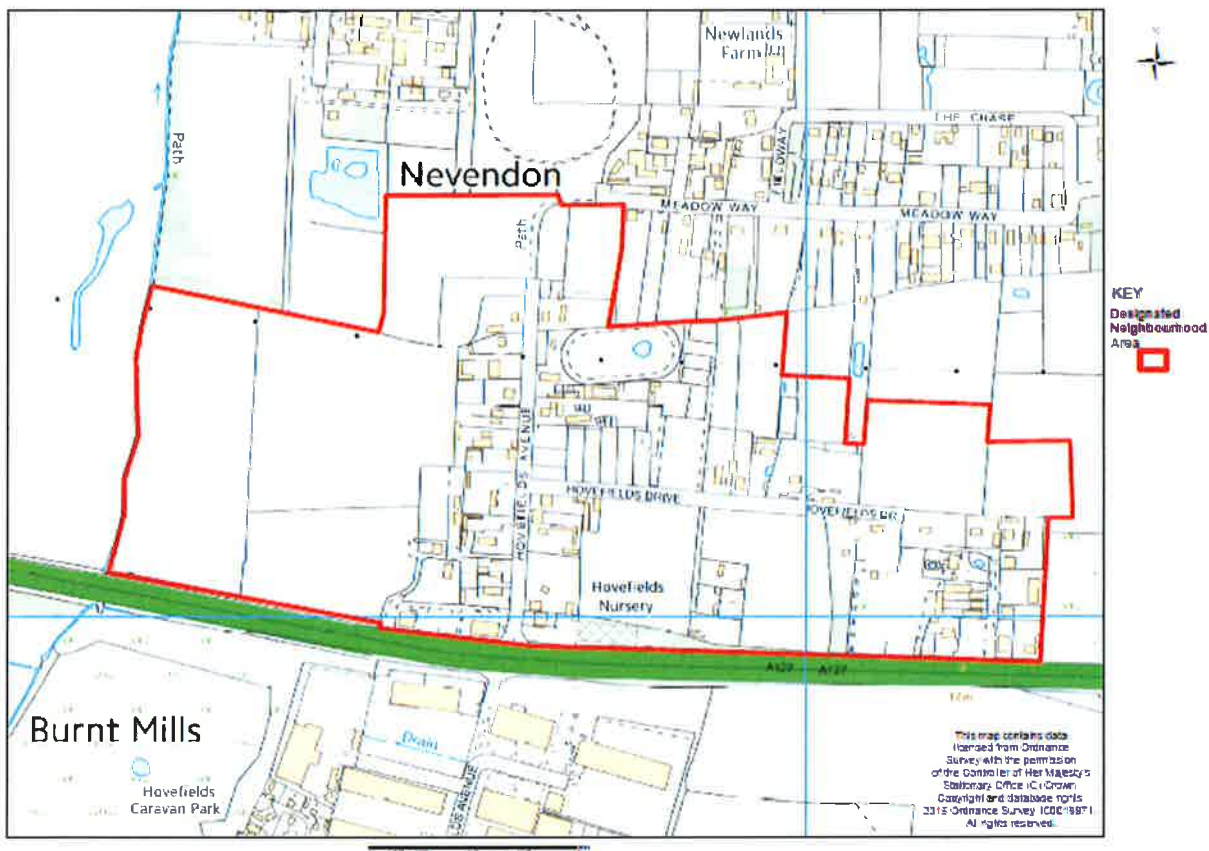
